The second **Global Anglican Future Conference** got underway in Kenya on Monday, comprising of leaders of some of the world's largest Anglican churches, with 1,200 delegates, clergy and laity, men and women from across of the Anglican Communion who will gather in Nairobi for a week-long meeting... **Anchor House**, a Catholic homeless charity, was Highly Commended as a 'Social Champion' at the **Charity Times Awards 2013** this week... Two charities have launched a project in London to support boys and young men who are victims of human trafficking, with **ECPAT UK** and **The Children's Society** coming together to support boys and young men who have been trafficked to the UK for reasons including sexual exploitation, forced labour or criminal exploitation. Some 549 children were identified as potential victims of human trafficking in 2012, a 12 per cent increase on the previous year, according to the **UK Human Trafficking Centre**. More than a third of the children identified (38 per cent) were boys...
